General Info:

- The Landmarks & Design Commission, by City Code Sections 1.14 and 15.210.050, has authority to conduct a public hearing, take testimony, & make recommendations on specific land use actions.
- The purpose of the **public hearing is to present information & to take public testimony** in an orderly manner. It is an "open record" public hearing that is open to give testimony, provide evidence, submit exhibits or provide other information. The record will be used by the Commission to make the decision, so it is important to provide all pertinent information. **The hearing will be recorded.**
- The Landmarks & Design Commission is the final decision-maker.

Hearing Procedure for Each COA:

1. Landmarks & Design Commission Chair to **call meeting to order**.
2. Landmarks & Commission to **proceed through listed agenda**, roll call, etc.
3. Landmarks & Design Commission to **identify Public Hearing item & open public hearing**.
4. The **City staff will give a staff report** on the matter. Report may include slides & will include verbal:
 - Presentation of the application submitted by the applicant.
 - Staff recommendation on proposal
5. The **Applicant** will present application for proposal.
6. The **Landmarks & Design Commission Chair will call for public testimony**.
7. **Any interested person may testify or comment** on the matter. **If you wish to speak, you must:**
 - Raise your "virtual hand" in the corner of the computer screen or press *9 on your phone
 - Wait to be called upon using your name, e-mail, or phone number used to log in to the teleconference.
 - When requested, speak your name and home address clearly.
 - Share your opinion, speak slowly, and clearly so that testimony can be recorded.
 - Ensure testimony is short (*generally 3 minutes*), to the point & does not repeat previous speakers. You can say that you agree with a previous speaker.
8. After public testimony is completed, the City staff or applicant may offer any rebuttal and answer any questions by the Planning Commission.
9. The Landmarks & Design Commission will then decide if they have enough information and if so, **close the public hearing and deliberate**. Once the public hearing is closed, no further testimony will be accepted unless the Commission reopens the hearing.
